During our initial two weeks Crane Class's primary emphasis has been on acquainting ourselves with the class routine and structure while gaining further insights into our unique identities. This week we have been exploring our sensory topic book "Goldilocks and the three Bears". Pupils have been learning the many ways we look at books and listen to stories. Pupils have been reading, sequencing and making sentences with the support of colourful semantics, symbols and pictures. Additionally, pupils have been developing their fine and gross motor skills in a range of art, mark making and sensory activities. During PE pupils have been exploring and working on mastering basic movements, including running, jumping, balancing and coordination, by using space and travelling in a variety of ways.

In Dove Class in Art the students used colours and palettes to mix the primary colours, to create their own Elmer, because it's good to be different.
